Bickford, being the owners in fee of all the land embraced in South Missoula and being the North Half of Section 28 Town 13 North Range 19 West; have caused the same to be surveyed and platted as shown in said plat and intend to file the same as a public record to be known and designated as SOUTH MISSOULA, and we do declare the streets and alleys therein as shown by said plat to be public and they are hereby dedicated to public use.

George F. Brooks being duly sworn on his oath deposes and says that he is a surveyor and that in the month of November, 1888, he executed a survey of the blocks, lots, streets and alleys represented by this plat and called South Missoula and said town was surveyed and laid out according to this plat, that the streets are 100 feet wide, except Stephens Ave which is 124 feet wide, that the alleys are 20 wide, and that stone monuments at all block corners and in streets have been set and marked with a cross.
