Haffee do hereby certify that we have caused to be surveyed, subdivided and platted into lots, blocks, streets and alleys, as shown by the plat and certificate of survey herewith annexed, the following described tract of land, to wit: - Situated in the S.W. Quarter of the N.E. Quarter, and the S.E. Quarter of the N. West Quarter of Section Seventeen, Township Thirteen North of Range Nineteen West, to be known and designated: Manitoba Addition, and the lands included in all streets, avenues, and alleys shown on said plat are hereby granted and donated to the use of the public forever.

Kennedy, being duly sworn, on oath says: I am a Civil Engineer, that during the month of December 1889, I executed a survey of the blocks, lots, streets and alleys represented by this plat and called Manitoba Addition, that said Manitoba Addition was surveyed and laid out according to this plat, that Greenough Avenue is one hundred feet wide, that Hartley and Donley streets are each eighty feet wide, that Fifth, Sixth, Seventh, Eighth, Ninth and Tenth streets are each eighty feet wide, that the alleys in said addition are twenty feet wide and at the corners of blocks I have planted iron pins and have set Stone monuments at the intersection of the streets as shown on this plat.

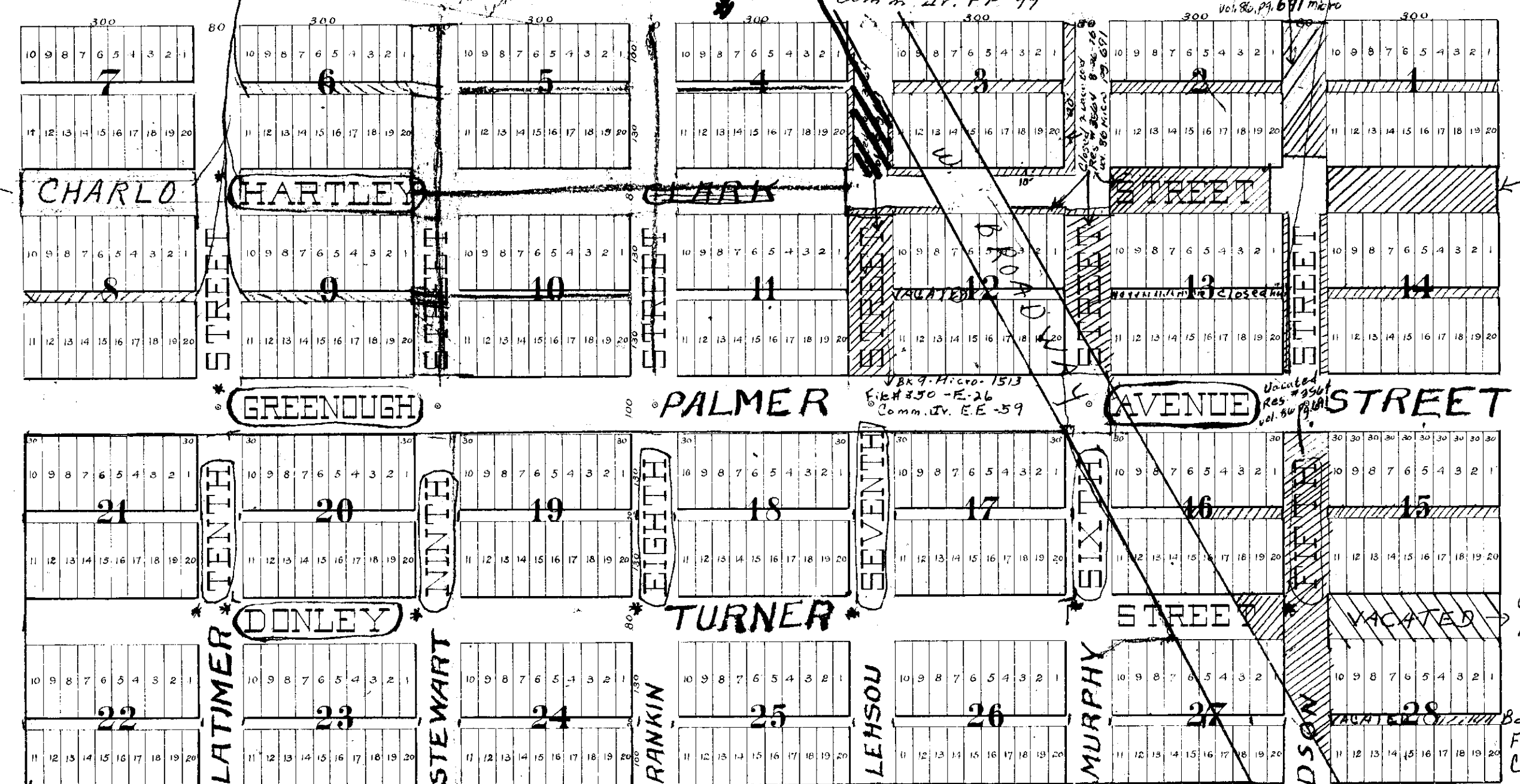
