George B. Proctor, duly sworn on his oath deposes and says that he is a civil engineer, that on the month of January, 1890 he executed a survey of the blocks lots streets and alleys represented by this map and called 'Knowles Addition No. 2' to the City of Missoula, that said addition was surveyed and laid out according to this map, that the blocks are eight feet wide and the alleys are twenty feet wide, except South Sixth Street which is only five feet wide and the streets and alleys as shown on the plat hereunto annexed.
