NOTE - Red lines within blocks are building lines, which are 25 feet from and parallel to block lines. Red lines in streets are curb lines which are 20 feet distant and parallel to block lines on all streets excepting front street and Sherlaw Ave. Curb lines on front street and Sherlaw Ave. are 12 feet distant and parallel to block lines. Stone Monument, where distances are not given, stones are 50.00' from block corners excepting on Sherlaw Ave. which are 62.5' from block corners.
