RESOLUTION NO. 2015-008

REGULATING PARKING WITHIN HOULE MEADOWS SUBDIVISION ON MEGAN DRIVE, SECTION 30, T15N, R21W

WHEREAS, Houle Meadows subdivision was approved on February 23, 2005 subject twelve conditions of approval; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners amended the conditions of subdivision approval on January 11, 2010 to allow for water storage tanks and hydrants for fire protection; and

WHEREAS, a condition of subdivision approval required "No Parking" signage for the portion of the access road adjacent to the water storage tanks and hydrants; and

WHEREAS, said vehicles could block or severely delay emergency responders; and

WHEREAS, the Missoula Board of County Commissioners is authorized by §7-14-2106, M.C.A., to adopt regulations governing parking on County roads; and

WHEREAS, §61-8-705, M.C.A., authorizes the removal of illegally parked vehicles in conjunction with §61-8-353 through §61-8-355, M.C.A.; and

WHEREAS, the Missoula Board of County Commissioners, upon giving due notice, did hold a public hearing on Wednesday, January 28, 2015, starting at 1:30 p.m., in the County Administration Building (199 W Pine St.) in Missoula, Montana, for the purpose of hearing all evidence for or against the said proposal; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Missoula Board of County Commissioners that parking within the Houle Meadows Subdivision in Section 30, Township 15 North, Range 21 West, is hereby prohibited as shown on Exhibit 1; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the County Public Works Department and the County Fire Inspector have approved appropriate signs indicating the restrictions; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Missoula County Sheriff is hereby requested to take such action as is required to assure compliance with the parking regulations in the affected easements.

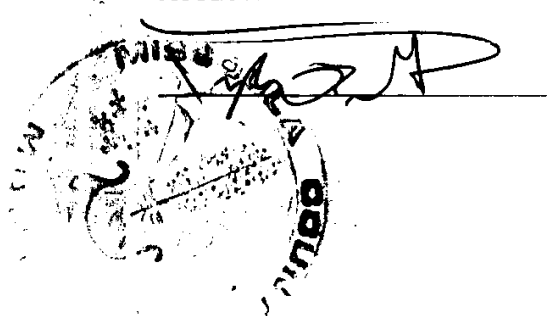
