RESOLUTION NO. 89-089

A RESOLUTION SETTING A 15 MPH SPEED LIMIT ON SAWMILL GULCH ROAD

WHEREAS, in accordance with MCA 61-8-310, the Board of County Commissioners has authority to establish special speed limits on county roads; and

WHEREAS, the 1985 Montana legislature amended MCA 61-8-310 to give the Board of County Commissioners authority to decrease the speed limit outside an urban district without an engineering and traffic investigation; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners may decrease said speed limit to not less than 15 MPH; and

WHEREAS, the Friends of the Rattlesnake a local area resident group has requested the speed limit be changed from 25 MPH to 15 MPH. The Board of County Commissioners has determined that 15 MPH is a safe and reasonable speed.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Missoula Board of County Commissioners do hereby establish a speed limit of 15 miles per hour on Sawmill Gulch Road from Rattlesnake Drive to the Forest Service Parking Lot in the Recreation Area and does hereby request the County Surveyor to cause the traffic signs on Sawmill Gulch Road to reflect this action.


