SPECIAL SCHOOL SPEED LIMIT OF 30 MPH FOR THE BONNER SCHOOL

WHEREAS, Missoula County received a request from Bonner School Officials for a special school speed limit for the Bonner School; and,

WHEREAS, the signs would portray a 30 mph limit during school crossing periods; and,

WHEREAS, during the remainder of the day and throughout non-school days the speed limit would revert back to Commission approved limit of 35 mph; and,

WHEREAS, the boundaries of the 30 mph zone would be from Station 7+00 to Station 21+00 on Project F-24-1 (3); and,

WHEREAS, based on the results of this traffic and engineering evaluation by the Montana Department of Transportation; and,

WHEREAS, the bouncing ball flashers on the school crossing remain; and,

WHEREAS, the Missoula County Board of County Commissioners discussed the matter with Darin Kaufman from Montana Department of Transportation at their Administrative Meeting on July 9, 1998;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Missoula Board of County Commissioners supports a special school speed limit of 30 mph in front of Bonner School.
