WHEREAS, the Planning and Zoning Commission and Board of County Commissioners of Missoula County created Zoning District 12A on September 29, 1974, by Resolution No. 219, under authority of Title 16, Chapter 41, Et. Seq., R.C.M. 1947; and,

WHEREAS, the Planning and Zoning Commission held a public hearing on August 16, 1978, for the purpose of reviewing and receiving public comment on a proposal to amend the regulations of Zoning District 12A; and,

WHEREAS, the Planning and Zoning Commission did adopt an amendment to Zoning District 12A requiring a minimum lot size of one-half acre.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of County Commissioners do hereby accept and approve the amendment requiring a minimum lot size of one-half acre in Zoning District 12A.
